Outcome of follow-up visit relating to the Independent School Standards (Wales) Regulations 2003

At the core inspection in March 2022, the school did not comply with the following regulations:

- Standard 1: The quality of education provided by the school
- Standard 3: The welfare, health and safety of the pupils
- Standard 5: The suitability of the premises and accommodation

Since the core inspection, the school has improved the quality and consistency of planning and assessment. Teaching staff now show a good understanding of the aptitudes, needs and prior attainment of the pupils and take these into account when planning lessons.

Classroom resources have been improved and additional space is now available for teaching which is used effectively.

The school has strengthened the policies relating to safeguarding, including having a robust traffic management policy and guidance for staff on the use of mobile phones. These policies pay appropriate regard to Welsh Government guidance. In addition, the school accurately records attendance and punctuality and has a clear rationale for engaging pupils in their learning.

As a result, the school is judged to have met the requirements for standards 1,3 and 5 of the Independent School Standards (Wales) Regulations 2003.
